There will be two entry categories: professional and amateur. Professional will be restaurants and amateurs are everyone else. There will also be a People's Choice award.

How Do I Enter? Fill out this form and return it to the Chamber of Commerce by **Wednesday, February 15, 2012** along with your \$10 entry fee. You will need to provide 1 gallon of your best hot toddy to be judged and enjoyed. You should also provide a way to keep the beverage warm (thermos, Cambro). There will be minimal electricity available. The chamber will provide:

- ◆ the tasting cups
- ◆ gallons of hot water and
- ◆ coffee for any coffee concoctions will be provided by Pagosa Coffee Roasting Company. They will also be on hand to sell regular coffee by the cup.

Winners will be awarded a hip Hot Toddy plaque to hang in your business or impress your friends with and perhaps some Pagosa Perks to keep your dollars local.

All contestants, tasters and participants, must be of legal drinking age and should come with a DD or risk being thrown into the freezing San Juan River to regain your senses.
